

Xcite Mini Rocks Fitness Event Terms and Conditions

- 1.All participants must register for the event by phoning or in person at the Xcite Bathgate reception
- a. By booking a space, each participant acknowledges and accepts these Terms and Conditions.
- b. All participants must be accompanied by an adult registered for the event.
 - c. Children under 8 and over 11 are not permitted to take part in the event.
- d. Upon booking, you agree that both adult and child are physically capable of participating in the Mini Rocks event.
 - e.On arrival at the event at registration, an emergency contact name and number must be provided.
 - 2. Parents and guardians are responsible for their child's safety.
 - 3. The registration fee contributes to the cost of staging the event and a surprise prize at the end of the event.
- 4.The registration fee is non-refundable. Transfer of a place is not permitted in any circumstances.
 - 5. The event has been organised with safety being paramount but by entering the Xcite Mini Rocks event you do so entirely at your own risk.

- 6.If you are involved in an accident and the situation arises that you are not capable of making the decision to call the emergency services, you agree that a member of the Xcite Team may call on your behalf. First aiders will be provided at the event.
